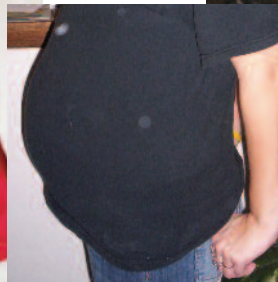

Diaper Tidbits from Katherine Hardacre and Pam White

Imagine a trail of diapers. The trail starts at Cinema 53 in Davenport and stretches along I-74 all the way to the Quad City Airport in Moline. If you took every diaper CPC Pregnancy Resources makes available to our clients throughout the year, it would span this entire path. We distribute approximately 130 dozen diapers each week. That's over 75,000 diapers each year. At 2 ounces each, that's the weight equivalent of over 1,600 gallons of Whitey's moose track ice cream!

Disposable diapers make a great incentive. Clients receive a certificate for two dozen diapers each time they participate in one of our parenting classes, abstinence sessions, or Bible studies. Although many clients come at first just to receive the diapers, we don't mind. Our goal is to build a relationship with them and share the gospel of Jesus. Many clients have chosen Christ and decided to follow Him after meeting with staff and volunteers at one of these classes

We are always in need of diapers here at the Center. At 15-cents a diaper, we could easily spend \$11,000 on diapers each year. That is why your diaper donations make such a big difference. We encourage you to consider buying a package of diapers on your next shopping trip. Depending on the brand, size, and quantity, a package will only set you back between \$6 and \$20. Thank you so much for your support!
